### **Course Requirements:**

**Testing Procedures:** Your skills and knowledge will be tested through your lab behavior, work ethic and application of knowledge on each project completed in the lab. You may expect occasional quizzes/tests. You will also be required to complete a Final Exam or Project at the end of the semester.

**Grading Procedures:** Student quarter and semester grades will be determined by dividing the total number of points actually earned by the total number of points possible to earn. The number of points possible for homework/classwork will vary according to the assignment. Quizzes/tests will be valued at 100 points each. Projects will also be valued at 100 points each. Each item for which you have earned points will be counted once.

**Requirements to Pass:** in order to pass and receive credit for this course the following list of assignments/projects (on the front) must be completed and turned in for evaluation by the due date specified in class. If a due date is missed, the grade will be reduced by 5 points for each day beyond the deadline. All assignments must be completed in order to pass this course. **Zeros are unacceptable and must be made up in order to receive a final grade.**

**Loss of Credit Policy:** Credit will be denied if a student misses more than 16 days in a semester course provided work is not made up.

**Makeup Credit Policy:** Make up work will be due the second day after the student returns to school. In the case of an extended absence arrangements will be made between the student and teacher.
